REQUIREMENTS FOR REPLACEMENT OF LOST PASSPORT

1. Personal appearance is required before a consular officer

For Lost Valid Passport

- a. Accomplished passport application form
- b. Must be in descent attire for photo taking
- c. Police Report
- d. Copy of Lost Passport
- e. Valid identification card (i.e. birth certificate, SSS, driving license, seaman book, comelec ID etc..)

For Expired Passport

- a. Accomplished passport application form
- b. Must be in descent attire for photo taking
- c. Copy of Lost Passport
- d. Valid identification card (i.e. birth certificate, SSS, driving license, seaman book, comelec ID etc..)
- 2. 15 days clearing period (from the receipt of mentioned requirements)
- 3. Payment of lost passport and other applicable fees payable to Embajada de la Republica de Filipinas in cash or bank manager / cashier's cheque only:

Lost ePassport fee:

US\$ 150.00 (M\$ 2,175.00)

Lost MRP Passport fee: US\$90.00 (M\$ 1,305.00)

Courier fee (optional):

US\$39.60 (M\$ 574.20) – outside Mexico

US\$20.00 (M\$ 290.00) - within Mexico

Bank clearing charge fee US\$ 2.32 (M\$ 33.65)

Processing period: four to six weeks. The issuance and production of MRPs are made in the Department of Foreign Affairs in Manila

NOTE: In compliance with ICAO regulations, the Philippine Government will ONLY ISSUE the new MAROON colored MACHINE READABLE PASSPORT (MRP) starting on 1 April 2010. Hence, green passports will no longer be issued effective on said date.
